Island Vacation Party Mix

2-1/2 cups Corn Chex

2-1/2 cups Rice Chex

2 cups Macadamia Nuts

¼ cup butter, cubed

2 Tbsp. Sugar

2 Tbsp. Corn syrup

1 cup flaked coconut

1 pkg. (6 oz.) chopped diced pineapple

1 cup white baking chips

In a large Microwave-safe bowl, combine cereals and nuts; set aside. In a small Microwave-safe bowl, combine butter, sugar and corn syrup. Microwave, uncovered on HIGH for 2 minutes, stirring once. Pour over cereal mixture and toss to coat.

Cook cereal mixture, uncovered on HIGH for 2 minutes stirring once. Add coconut; cook 2 minutes longer, stirring once. Spread out on waxed paper to cool. Stir in pineapple and chips. Store in an airtight container.
